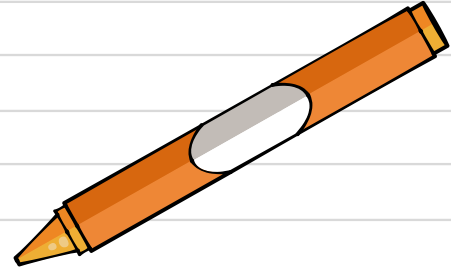


Grading
